This year we are explicitly teaching children the skills of problems solving in maths and we are now showing them the connection to using these skills in other areas of learning and also in real life – especially social situations. The key strategies we are all learning are: CLARIFY (what is the problem), CHOOSE (the best strategy to solve it), USE (apply it), INTERPRET (did it seem right), and COMMUNICATE (explain what you did).
